Refund Policy

In the event a student terminates their training, a refund will be made, if due, in accordance with the school's refund policy (as published in the school's catalog). An administrative fee equal to the lesser of \$100 or 5% of school charges assessed the student, will be retained by the school. All other fees are non-refundable.

Examples of refund policy upon request.

(925 Clock Hours Per Year)

A total of 9 months or 37 weeks is normally required for completion of each program. A student upon completion of the first year will have accumulated 925 clock hours, upon completion of the second year will have accumulated 1850 clock hours, and upon completion of the third year will have accumulated 2775 clock hours.

An annual finance charge of 18% (1.5% per month) will be assessed on monies received after due date.
